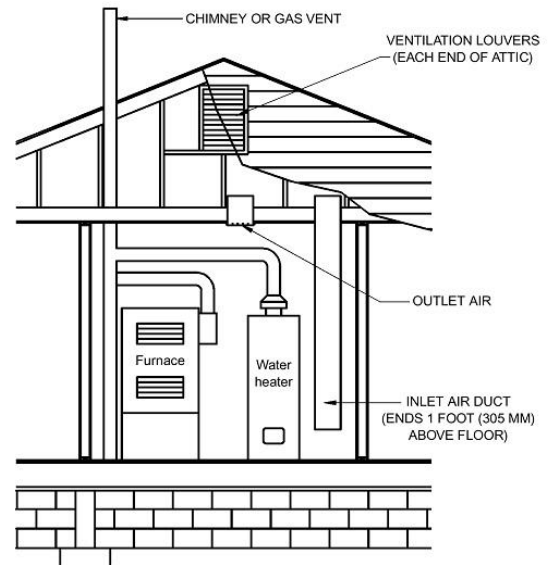
How to calculate
